2009-187 An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “AA” Liquor Licenses By One Due To Voluntary Relinquishment By Shelia’s Place Inc. D/B/A Farley’s Pub, 300 E. Washington Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Shelia’s Place Inc. d/b/a Farley’s Pub currently hold a Class “AA” liquor license for the business located at 300 E. Washington Street and has voluntarily relinquished the Class “AA” license. This ordinance will authorize a decrease in the number of Class “AA” liquor licenses from 44 to 43. A Class “AA” liquor license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, at retail, for consumption either on the premises by the drink or pitcher or off the premises when sold in the original package and is a 1 a.m. license.

2009-188 An Ordinance Authorizing A Decrease In The Number Of Class “B” Liquor Licenses By One Due To Closure Of Business By Bickey (II) Corporation D/B/A Midway Discount Warehouse, 724 South Grand Avenue East (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Bickey (II) Corporation d/b/a Midway Discount Warehouse, currently hold a Class “B” liquor license for the business located at 724 South Grand Avenue East and has closed the business. This ordinance will authorize a decrease in the number of Class “B” liquor licenses from 40 to 48. A Class “B” license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor in the original package, for consumption off premises only and is a 1 a.m. license.

2009-189 An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “A” Liquor Licenses By One And Increase The Number Of Class “D” Liquor Licenses By One For Benanti King Pin Lanes, L.L.C. D/B/A King Pin Lanes, 3115 Sangamon Avenue (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Benanti King Pin Lanes, L.L.C. d/b/a King Pin Lanes (Licensee), currently hold a Class “A” liquor license for the business located at 3115 Sangamon Avenue. The Licensee desires to relinquish the Class “A” liquor license and has applied for a Class “D” liquor license. This ordinance will decrease the number of Class “A” liquor licenses from 26 to 25 and increase the number of Class “D” liquor licenses from 75 to 76. A Class “D” license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic by the drink or pitcher as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only and is a 1 a.m. license.

2009-190 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Subclass 1 Liquor Licenses By One For Capitol City Lodge 1160 Elks D/B/A Capitol City Lodge 1160, 1800 E. Brown Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

This ordinance is to increase the number of SubClass “1” liquor licenses by one to Capitol City Lodge 1160 Elks, d/b/a Capitol City Lodge 1160, 1800 East Brown, Springfield, IL 62703. A Sub Class “1” license entitles the licensee to stay open till 3 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday mornings. This would increase the number of SubClass “1” licenses from two to three. The licensee currently holds a Class “G” liquor license and this is an additional license. A Class “G” is a tavern license allowing the licensee to sell for onsite consumption from glass or pitcher only and is a 1 a.m. license.

2009-191 An Ordinance Accepting The Lowest Responsible Bid And Authorizing Execution Of Contract Number FD09-02-115 With Henson Robinson Company For Roof Replacement At Firehouse #3 In An Amount Not To Exceed \$50,772.00 Plus A Field Modification Allowance Of \$5,078.00 For A Total Not To Exceed \$55,850.00 (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

This contract will provide for roof replacement for Fire Station #3 roof system. (Description of proposed contract FD09-02-115) Henson Robinson is the low bidder and it is the recommendation of the Chief of the department that this contract be awarded to Henson Robinson in the amount of \$55,850. (Bid amount plus 10% in case of any unforeseen additions roof decking etc)
