**2008-625** An Ordinance Amending Section 91.01 Of The 1988 City Of Springfield Code Of Ordinances, As Amended, Pertaining To The Definition Of A Disturbance Regarding Animals (**Requested By Ald. Theilen**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)(**Remains In Committee 9/16/08**)

**2008-921** An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance Number 342-05-08 Authorizing Execution Of A Development Agreement With Abundant Faith Ministry To Provide Infrastructure Improvements For A 60-Unit Supportive Living Facility At 2521 Empowerment Drive Utilizing Home Funds In An Amount Not To Exceed \$75,000.00, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**) (**Remains In Committee 1/5/09**)

**2009-023** An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Subclass 2 Liquor Licenses By One For Central Pointe Inc., D/B/A Bar None, 427 E. Monroe Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Central Pointe Inc., D/B/A Bar None, located at 427 E. Monroe Street, currently holds a Class "A" liquor license that entitles the licensee to operate a tavern and sell alcoholic beverages for onsite consumption from a glass or pitcher and is a 1 a.m. license. In order for the licensee to remain open until 3 a.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings, a

Subclass “2” license is required. The licensee has applied for a Subclass “2” license, if approved, will increase the number of Subclass “2” licenses from six to seven.

**2009-024** An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “A” Liquor Licenses By Two Due To Relinquishment Of License By Bob Meyer And Darla Rendleman D/B/A Trim, Located At 441 E. Adams Street, And Due To Closure Of Business By We Bar 2, Inc. D/B/A Frankie’s Main Gate, Located At 2143 N. 11<sup>th</sup> Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Bob Meyer and Darla Rendleman D/B/A TRIM, 441 E. Adams Street, currently holds a Class “A” liquor license and desires to relinquish the license back to the City. W Bar 2, Inc. D/B/A Frankie’s Main Gate, currently holds a Class “A” liquor license for the business located at 2143 N. 11<sup>th</sup> Street and the licensee has closed the business. This ordinance will decrease the number of Class “A” liquor licenses from 29 to 27. A Class “A” license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, at retail, for consumption on the premises by the drink or pitcher only and is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-025** An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “AA” Liquor Licenses By Two Due To The Closure Of Business By HC&C Bar Inc. D/B/A North End Pub, Located At 1222 N. 19<sup>th</sup> Street, And Due To Relinquishment Of The License By EW’s Bar & Grill, Inc., Located At 726 North Grand Avenue East (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

HC&C Bar Inc. D/B/A North End Pub, currently holds a Class “AA” liquor license for the business at 1222 N. 19<sup>th</sup> Street and the licensee has closed the business. EW’s Bar & Grill, Inc. currently holds a Class “AA” liquor license for the business located at 726 North Grand Avenue East and desires to relinquish the license back to the City. This ordinance will approve a decrease in the number of Class “AA” liquor licenses from 45 to 43. A Class “AA” license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, at retail, for consumption either on the premises by the drink or pitcher or off the premises when sold in the original package. Class “AA” licenses are 1 a.m. licenses.

**2009-026** An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Class “AA” Liquor Licenses By One For Frank Reynolds D/B/A Old Timers Lounge, 2143 N. 11<sup>th</sup> Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Frank Reynolds D/B/A Old Timers Lounge, has applied for a Class “AA” liquor license for the business located at 2143 N. 11<sup>th</sup> Street. A Class “AA” liquor license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, at retail, for consumption either on the premises by the drink or pitcher or off the premises when sold in the original package and is a 1 a.m. license. This ordinance will increase the number of Class “AA” liquor licenses from 43 to 44.

**2009-027** An Ordinance Authorizing A Decrease In The Number Of Class “B1” Liquor Licenses Due To Closure Of Business By Artina International Grocery Store, LLC, 614 North Grand Avenue East (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Artina International Grocery Store, LLC currently holds a Class “B1” liquor license for the business located at 614 North Grand Avenue East and the licensee has closed the business. This ordinance will approve a decrease in the number of Class “B1” liquor licenses from three to two. A Class “B1” license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor in the original package only, for consumption off premises. Beer and wine can be sold from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.

**2009-028** An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “C1” Liquor Licenses By One Due To The Relinquishment Of The License By Global Perspectives, Inc. D/B/A It’s A Wrap, 979 Clock Tower Drive **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

Global Perspectives, Inc. D/B/A It’s a Wrap, currently holds a class “C1” liquor license for the business at 979 Clock Tower Drive. The licensee desires to relinquish the license back to the City so this ordinance will approve a decrease in the number of Class “C1” liquor licenses from three to two. A Class “C1” license entitles the licensee to sell beer and wine only, in the original package, for consumption off premises, from 7 a.m. until 10 p.m., Monday through Sunday and is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-029** An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “D” Liquor Licenses From 77 To 73 Due To The Relinquishment Of Licenses Or Closure Of Businesses For: Boone’s Uptown Grill Inc., Q. Of Springfield, Inc. D/B/A Qdoba Mexican Grill, Green Onions Entertainment, Inc. D/B/A Willy Mac’s And CLT, Inc. D/B/A Tuscany Italian Restaurant **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

The following businesses currently hold Class “D” liquor licenses and Boone’s Uptown Grill Inc. has closed the business located at 301 W. Edwards Street; Q of Springfield, Inc. D/B/A Qdoba Mexican Grill no longer wishes to sell alcohol as part of their business at 2917 W. Iles Avenue; Green Onions Entertainment, Inc. D/B/A Willy Mac’s, has closed the business located at 1975 Wabash Avenue and Clt, Inc. D/B/A Tuscany Italian Restaurant has closed the business at 3123 Robbins Road. This ordinance will decrease the number of Class “D” liquor licenses from 77 to 73. A Class “D” license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor by the drink or pitcher as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on premise only and is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-030** An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Class “D” Liquor Licenses By One For Mangia Bene Of Springfield, Inc. D/B/A Mangia Bene At Two Olives Cantina, 518 E. Adams Street **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

Mangia Bene of Springfield, Inc. D/B/A Mangia Bene at Two Olives Cantina has applied for a Class “D” liquor license for the business located at 518 E. Adams Street. A Class “D” license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption of premises only and is a 1 a.m. license. This ordinance will increase the number of Class “D” licenses from 73 to 74.

**2009-031** An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “E” Liquor Licenses By One Due To The Closure Of Business By NPC International, Inc. D/B/A Pizza Hut #2636, 1420 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

NPC International, Inc. D/B/A Pizza Hut #2636, currently holds a Class “E” liquor license for the business located at 1420 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street. The licensee has closed the business so this ordinance will decrease the number of Class “E” liquor licenses from 29 to 28. A class “E” license entitles the licensee to sell beer and wine only, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only and is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-032** An Ordinance Authorizing The Execution Of An Intergovernmental Agreement With The State Of Illinois Department Of Agriculture For Use Of The Illinois State Fairgrounds For Training Purposes And Other Activities (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

This agreement will allow access to and control over a portion of the Illinois State Fairgrounds for use in training for Police and Fire Departments and other activities throughout the term beginning January 1, 2009, through December 31, 2009.

**2009-033** An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of Subrecipient Agreement 08-Sr-0002 With Helping Hands Of Springfield, Inc. For Operation Of The Springfield Overflow Shelter Located At 501 E. Capitol Avenue Utilizing The City’s Community Development Block Grant Funds In An Amount Not To Exceed \$15,000.00, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

An Ordinance authorizing OPED to enter into Subrecipient Agreement 08-SR-0002, with Helping Hands of Springfield, Inc., to provide \$15,000 in CDBG funds to support the Springfield Overflow Shelter. The shelter will operate from November 1, 2008, through April 30, 2009, at First Methodist Church, 501 East Capitol Avenue. The shelter is needed to provide bed space that is not available at any of the City’s permanent shelters.

**2009-034** An Ordinance Approving A Grant In Connection With The City Of Springfield’s Home Deferred Loan Program, Case Number HDL 08-07, And Authorizing Payment To Turner-Bailey, Inc. For Rehabilitation Assistance In An Amount Not To Exceed \$59,195.00 For The Property Located At 908 S. Walnut Street For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

The City is an entitlement city under the regulations of the U.S. Department of HUD’s HOME Program and rehabilitation of single-family homes for very low income persons is an eligible activity for HOME program dollars. The project requesting funding is a rehabilitation loan which is provided to very low income person in Springfield in order to bring his house up to City Building Code Standards. The homeowners are qualified by the Office of Planning & Economic Development and provided with a deferred forgivable loan to rehabilitate their homes. The scope of work varies slightly by project but generally

includes repair of heating roofing, electrical, plumbing systems and removal of leadbase paint hazards.

**2009-035** An Ordinance Amending Chapter 131, Of The 1988 City Of Springfield Code Of Ordinances, As Amended, By Adding The Offenses Of Unlawful Possession Of Cannabis, Unlawful Possession Of Drug Paraphernalia And Unlawful Sale Or Possession Of Tobacco (**Requested By Ald. Simpson**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

This ordinance would add the offenses of unlawful possession of cannabis, unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia, and unlawful sale or possession of tobacco to the City Code so that the offenses could be prosecuted by the City as ordinance violations in lieu of referring them to the State's Attorney's office for prosecution.
