2009-190 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Subclass 1 Liquor Licenses By One For Capitol City Lodge 1160 Elks D/B/A Capitol City Lodge 1160, 1800 E. Brown Street **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)(Remains in Committee 4/20/09)**

2009-289 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Class "A" Liquor Licenses By One For Scandals Inc., 2901 Chatham Road. **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

Scandals Inc. has applied for a Class "A" liquor license for the business located at 2901 Chatham Road. If approved, this will increase the number of Class "A" liquor licenses from 26 to 27. A Class "A" license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, at retail, for consumption on the premises by the drink or pitcher only and is a 1 a.m. license.

2009-290 An Ordinance Authorizing A Transfer Of Funds From One Account To Another Within The Same Fund In The Amount Of \$8,000.00 For The Office Of The Mayor, Senior Citizens Commission. **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

The Office of the Mayor, Senior Citizen Commission, needs to transfer existing budget authority to prepare to remit funds to Grahman and Hyde for an existing contract and

supervision of the Senior Center roof replacement project. The \$8,000.00 is carryover budget authority which was not used during FY2009. Ordinance 309.05.08 authorized up to \$32,000.00 and payments to date total \$24,000.00.

2009-291 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of A Contract With The Board Of Trustees Of The University Of Illinois For The Provision Of Fire Protection Services From July 1, 2009, Through June 30, 2010. **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

This contract amount represents a three percent (3.0%) increase over the amount of the previous contract approved by Ordinance No. 209-04-09 (covering the time period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009)

2009-292 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of Amendment No. 2 To An Economic Development Agreement Between The City Of Springfield, Illinois, And Qik N EZ Properties, L.L.C., For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development. **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

This ordinance will amend ordinance 419-08-01 and extends the length of the loan to Qik-N-EZ Properties, LLC located within the boundaries of the Enos Park TIF.

2009-293 An Ordinance Accepting And Authorizing Execution Of An Illinois Liquor Control Commission Grant For The "Kids Can't Buy 'Em Here" Campaign, From August 1, 2009, Through June 30, 2010, In The Amount Of \$14,300.00 And Authorizing A Supplemental Appropriation In The Amount Of \$9,532.00 For The Springfield Police Department. **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

An ordinance authorizing the acceptance, execution and supplemental appropriation of a grant from the Illinois Liquor Control Commission, "Kids Can't Buy'em Here" Tobacco Grant in the amount of \$14,300.00 for the Springfield Police Department. Commencing on August 1, 2009 and ending on June 30, 2010. The grant authorized overtime for officers to check vendors that sell tobacco a total of three times during the grant period, to ensure they are not selling to underage persons. There is no agreement number, non-federal funds. Reporting Category ILC9. We are only budgeting for FY10's funding.

2009-294 An Ordinance Authorizing The Execution Of An Intergovernmental Agreement With Sangamon County Department Of Public Health For Boarding Services Of Unclaimed, Impounded Animals In An Amount Not To Exceed \$97,160.00 From May 1, 2009, Through April 30, 2010, And Authorizing A Supplemental Appropriation In The Amount Of \$97,160.00 From Unanticipated, Unbudgeted Fund Balance **(Requested By Mayor Timothy J. Davlin) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

Pursuant to provisions of 5 ILSC 5/1-1001, et seq., a County Board of Health may enter into contracts with municipalities for the purchase, sale or exchange of health services. The Sangamon County Department of Public Health has been designated as the supervising and administrative agent to administer and oversee all animal control functions as defined in

the Illinois Animal Control Act and County ordinances. The City does not currently pay for boarding of unclaimed animals that are impounded within City limits. This ordinance will authorize execution of an agreement with Sangamon County to provide animal control services and authorize payment to Sangamon County in an amount not to exceed \$97,160.00 from May 1, 2009, through April 30, 2010, and authorizing a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$97,160.00 from unanticipated, unbudgeted fund balance.

2009-295 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of An Amendment To A Redevelopment Agreement With The Illinois Community College System Foundation For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

The existing redevelopment agreement was approved by ordinance number 691-10-07. The Illinois Community College System Foundation is utilizing TIF assistance for building rehabilitation (\$45,449.80), ADA Elevator installation (\$50,000.00) and Streetscape Grant (\$60,000.00). The total amount of assistance is \$155,449.80. This ordinance approves an extension of the project completion date until 12/31/2010.

2009-296 An Ordinance Accepting The Lowest Responsible Bid And Authorizing Execution Of Contract Number CS09-01-101 With Evans Construction Co. For The 1908 Race Riot Commemoration Sculpture Site Work At Union Plaza Park In An Amount Not To Exceed \$31,500.00, Plus An Additional \$6,000.00 For Work Related To Unforeseen Circumstances, For A Total Amount Not To Exceed \$37,500.00 And Authorizing A Reappropriation Of FY09 Fund Balance In The Amount Of \$23,000.00 And Authorizing A Supplemental Appropriation In An Amount Of \$14,500.00 From Tax Increment Finance Funds (**Requested By Mayor Timothy J. Davlin**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

The Office of the Mayor received a \$300,000.00 grant from the Capital Development Board for the design of a commemorative 1908 Race Riot statue. The statue is complete \$277K of the \$300K was paid to Preston Jackson. This will reappropriate the balance of \$23,000.00 from the fund balance and supplementally appropriates \$14,500.00 from TIF to complete the placement of the artwork in Union Square Park.
