2009-190 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Subclass 1 Liquor Licenses By One For Capitol City Lodge 1160 Elks D/B/A Capitol City Lodge 1160, 1800 E. Brown Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)(**Remains in Committee 4/20/09**)

2009-312 An Ordinance Authorizing A Decrease In The Number Of Class "B1" Liquor Licenses By One And Authorizing An Increase In The Number Of Class "B" Liquor Licenses By One For D.J. Development, LLC D/B/A Jiffi Stop #12, 456 South Grand Avenue East (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

This ordinance is to decrease the number of Class "B1" liquor licenses by one and to increase the number of Class "B" liquor licenses by one for D.J. Development, LLC d/b/a Jiffi Stop #12, 456 South Grand Avenue East. A Class "B1" license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor in the original package, for consumption of premises only. The license also entitles the licensee to sell beer and wine from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. A Class "B" license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor in the original package for consumption off premises only and entitles the licensee to sell beer and wine. This is a 1 a.m. license. This would decrease the number of Class "B1" liquor licenses from two to one and increase the number of Class "B" liquor license from 48 to 49.

2009-313 An Ordinance Accepting The Lowest Bid And Authorizing The Execution Of Contract Number CV10-04-22 With Phillips Brothers Printers For The Printing Of The 2010 Visitors Guide For The Convention And Visitors Bureau For A Total Amount Not To Exceed \$75,055.00 **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

The Springfield Convention and Visitors Bureau sought bids for printing and storing 225,000 2010 Visitors Guides. Phillips Brothers Printers was the low bidder. We are applying for a 60/40 grant through the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Development. Therefore, it was necessary for us to start the bid process earlier than usual. Contract #CV10-04-22.

2009-314 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of A Grant Agreement With TSP-Hope, Inc., A Not-For-Profit Community Housing Development Organization, For The Construction Of New Houses In Census Tracts 15 And 17 With The Use Of The City's Home Funds, In An Amount Not To Exceed \$275,000.00, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

The CHDO project is to provide sage and affordable home ownership. The project addresses are 716 S. 13th, 1201 East Edwards, 1226 East Jackson, 1402 East Jackson and 529 South 12th. The scope is to include construction and/or buydown.

2009-315 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of A Starcom21 User Agreement With, And Authorizing Payment Of \$101,880.00 To, Motorola, Inc. For The Office Of Homeland Security Department Of Emergency Communications **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

This agreement is for the use of the Starcom 21 Radio System by the City of Springfield Police Department and Office of Homeland Security, Bureau of Emergency Communications. This agreement calls for payment of \$8,490.00 per month for Starcom use on a total of 330 units (combination of mobiles, portable radios and control stations). This is a one year agreement that commences on execution of the contract.

2009-316 An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 225-04-08 And Ordinance No. 207-04-09 Ratifying The City's Lease For The Southeast Branch Of Lincoln Library At 2500 South Grand Avenue East For The Period March 1, 2008, Through February 28, 2010, And Changing The Name Of The Lessor Under Said Lease From Sam Nudo To The Wanda M. Nudo 1999 Marital Trust, Dated April 23, 1999, For Lincoln Library **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

The City Council previously passed Ordinance No. 225-04-08 authorizing payments in an amount not to exceed \$16,200.00 to Sam and Wanda Nudo for rental payments in connection with a lease of rental space for the Southeast Branch of Lincoln Library located at 2500 South Grand Avenue East, Springfield, Illinois, for the period March 1, 2008 through February 28, 2009. As of March 1, 2008, the Wanda M. Nudo 1999 Marital Trust, Dated April 23, 1999, was the actual record owner of the rental space, and A. Sam Nudo and Patrick R. Nudo were the co-trustees of said trust; and it is in the best interest of the

City to amend Ordinance No. 225-04-08 and Ordinance No. 207-04-09 to change the name of the lessor from Sam Nudo to the Wanda M. Nudo 1999 Marital Trust, Dated April 23, 1999, to delete the second and third preambles in both ordinances referencing the prior 1996 lease agreement and automatic renewal, respectively, and to authorize the Office of Budget and Management to begin making payments to A. Sam Nudo and Patrick R. Nudo, as a co-trustees of the Wanda M. Nudo 1999 Marital Trust, Dated April 23, 1999.
