2009-080 An Ordinance Authorizing Acceptance And Execution Of The 2008 Illinois Citizen Corps Program Grant From The Illinois Emergency Management Agency In The Amount Of \$5,000.00 And Authorizing A Supplemental Appropriation Of The Grant Funds For The Springfield Fire Department (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

This grant is a 100% grant with no percentage match by the City. This grant is for Citizen Corps Council activities for period January 1, 2009 – December 31, 2009, including: Resource tracking software – 1 year subscription, Citizen outreach materials for Neighborhood Watch Programs, Printer and supplies for Citizen Corps Program organizations, Sign language classes for Citizen Corps Program members.

2009-081 An Ordinance Accepting The Lowest Responsible Bid And Authorizing Execution Of Contract Number SC 09-11-96 With Henson Robinson Company For Roof Replacement And Related Electrical Work At The Senior Services Of Central Illinois

Building In An Amount Not To Exceed \$169,206.00 Plus A Field Modification Allowance Of \$10,000.00 For A Total Not To Exceed \$179,206.00 **(Requested By Ald. Dove)**

A contract with Henson Robinson Company to remove and replace the roof and related electrical work needed at the Senior Services of Central Illinois Building not to exceed \$179,206.00.

2009-082 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of Change Order No. 1 With Siciliano Inc And Authorizing Additional Payment In The Amount Of \$44,714.22 For A Total Not To Exceed \$240,923.22 Under Contract No. ED08-05-32 For Renovations To The Bourbon Street Building Located At 1031 South Grand Avenue East, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development **(Requested By Ald. Dove)** **(Public Affairs And Safety)**

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 573.08.07 (An ordinance accepting the lowest responsible bid and authorizing the execution of contract no. ED08-05-32 with Siciliano, Inc. for renovations to the Bourbon Street Building located at 1031 South Grand Avenue East, utilizing Community Development Block Grant Funds in an amount not to exceed \$196,209.00) by accepting Change Order No. 1 and authorizing an additional \$44,714.22, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$240,923.22. Change Order No. 1 contains 1) increased cost to contract due to delay in starting because of difficulties in resolving issues required for a building permit to be issued; 2) change to entry of building mandated by code; 3) existing electrical service to 3-phase in lieu of single phase; 4) provide and install Nixolite Bird Control at brick parapets; 5) remove and replace six roof joists; 6) rebuild and tuck-point the south and angle wall.

2009-083 An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 41-01-09 To Correct The Revenue Accounting String For The Springfield Police Department **(Requested By Ald. Dove)** **(Public Affairs And Safety)**

The Springfield Police Department is requesting an amendment to the original ordinance to correct the revenue account string line, from 001-107-BMGT-3460, to 001-112-POLC-POPR-3460. Misc. revenues are deposited in the agencies misc. revenue account line not in the Office of Budget and Management's revenue line. The original ordinance did not reflect the correct accounting string.

2009-084 A Resolution For Temporary Closure Of A Portion Of Illinois State Routes 97 And 125 (Jefferson Street From 9th To 5th Streets) For The St. Patrick's Day Parade On March 14, 2009 **(Requested By Ald. Lesko)** **(Public Affairs And Safety)**

This request is for the annual St. Patrick's Day Parade. The Parade will stage on Jefferson then travel west to 5th Street, south to Capitol, East to 6th Street, North to Washington and disband.
