2009-190 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Subclass 1 Liquor Licenses By One For Capitol City Lodge 1160 Elks D/B/A Capitol City Lodge 1160, 1800 E. Brown Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)(**Remains in Committee 4/20/09**)

2009-249 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Class "A" Liquor Licenses By One For Touch Of Class Sports Bar & Grill, Inc., 1031 S. 11th Street (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Touch of Class Sports Bar & Grill, Inc. d/b/a Touch of Class Sports Bar & Grill, has applied for a Class "A" liquor license for the business at 1031 S. 11th Street. This ordinance, if approved, will increase the number of Class "A" liquor licenses from 25 to 26. A Class "A" license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a tavern business, for consumption on the premises only.

2009-250 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Class "D" Liquor Licenses By One For Mike's Family Restaurant, Inc., 1401 S. Dirksen Parkway (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Mike's Family Restaurant, Inc., d/b/a Mike's Family Restaurant has applied for a Class "D" liquor license for the business located at 1401 S. Dirksen Parkway. A Class "D"

license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only and is a 1 a.m. license. This will increase the number of Class “D” licenses from 76 to 77.

2009-251 An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Subclass 2 Liquor Licenses By One For The Plaza On Adams, Inc., 406 E. Adams Street **(Requested By Ald. Lesko)** **(Public Affairs And Safety)**

The Plaza on Adams, Inc. d/b/a The Plaza, has applied for a Subclass “2” liquor license for the business at 406 E. Adams Street. A Subclass “2” liquor license entitles the licensee to stay open until 3 a.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings. This would increase the number of Subclass “2” licenses from seven to eight. This is an additional license to what the licensee already has which is a Class “A” (Tavern license) that allows the licensee to sell onsite for consumption from a glass or pitcher only and is a 1 a.m. license.

2009-252 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of A Sponsorship Agreement With, And Payment In The Amount Of \$50,000.00 To, Capital Area Sports Commission For The 2009 World Horseshoe Pitching Tournament To Be Held In Springfield From July 27, 2009, Through August 8, 2009, For The Springfield Convention And Visitors Bureau **(Requested By Ald. Lesko)** **(Public Affairs And Safety)**

The Springfield CVB has agreed to provide a \$50,000.00 sponsorship through International Marketing Grant #09-373004 received from the Illinois Dept. of Commerce & Economic Opportunity. The sponsorship will help support the 2009 World Horseshoe Pitching Tournament being held in Springfield from July 27 through August 8, 2009.

2009-253 An Ordinance Authorizing The Third Year’s Payment In The Amount Of \$18,565.00 To EBSCO To Furnish Unlimited Electronic Access To An Online Periodical Database Collection Service For Lincoln Library **(Requested By Ald. Lesko)** **(Public Affairs And Safety)**

EBSCO provides access to its databases through its reference websites and research products. The Electronic Database – EBSCO – provides unlimited onsite as well as remote access to an online periodical database service.

2009-254 An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of An Agreement With Ferry & Associates Architects, LLC And Authorizing Expenditure Of Tax Increment Finance Funds In The Total Amount Of \$137,400.00 For Streetscape Plans In The Downtown TIF District, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development **(Requested By Ald. Lesko)** **(Public Affairs And Safety)**

TIF funding for Streetscape plans for 5th, 6th and Washington Streets, within the boundaries of the Central Area Tax Increment Finance District.

2009-255 An Ordinance Accepting The Lowest Responsible Bid And Authorizing Execution Of Contract Number PD09-01-111 With Henson Robinson Company For Roof

Replacement At The Springfield Police Academy In An Amount Not To Exceed \$46,414.00, Plus A Field Modification Allowance Of \$10,000.00, For A Total Not To Exceed \$56,414.00 **(Requested By Ald. Lesko) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

The roof at the Police Academy is in a state of disrepair and leaking inside the building. To avoid interior damage a new roof is needed.

2009-258 An Ordinance Amending Chapter 33 Of The 1988 City Of Springfield, Code Of Ordinances, As Amended, By Adding Article XLIV, To Establish A Homeless Advisory Committee **(Requested By Mayor Timothy J. Davlin) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

This ordinance will amend Chapter 33 of the 1988 City of Springfield Code of Ordinances, as amended, by adding Article XLIV, Section 34.040-34.041 establishing a Homeless Advisory Committee pursuant to ordinance number 208-11-07.
