**2008-625** An Ordinance Amending Section 91.01 Of The 1988 City Of Springfield Code Of Ordinances, As Amended, Pertaining To The Definition Of A Disturbance Regarding Animals (**Requested By Ald. Theilen**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)(**Remains In Committee 9/16/08**)

3. **Ordinances for Committee Consideration**

**2009-108** An Ordinance Authorizing An Increase In The Number Of Class "B" Liquor Licenses By One For Highland Park CVS, L.L.C., D/B/A CVS/Pharmacy #5602, 611 South Grand Avenue East (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Highland Park CVS, L.L.C. d/b/a CVS / Pharmacy #5602, has applied for a Class "B" liquor license for the business located at 611 South Grand Avenue East. A Class "B" license entitles the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, in the original package only, for consumption off premises only. If approved, this will increase the number of Class "B" liquor licenses from 47 to 48 and is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-109** An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class "E" Liquor Licenses By One Due To Voluntary Relinquishment By Poon Corporation D/B/A Chinese Kitchen, 608 S. 9<sup>th</sup> Street (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Poon Corporation d/b/a Chinese Kitchen, currently holds a Class "E" liquor license for the business at 608 S. 9<sup>th</sup> Street and has voluntarily relinquished the Class "E" liquor license.

This ordinance will decrease the number of Class “E” liquor licenses from 28 to 27. A class “E” license entitles the licensee to sell beer and wine only, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only and is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-110** An Ordinance To Decrease The Number Of Class “E” Liquor Licenses By One Due To The Closure Of Business By Kinoy Phanthourath D/B/A Thai Kitchen, 620 N. 9<sup>th</sup> Street **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

This ordinance is to decrease the number of Class “E” liquor licenses from 27 to 26 due to the closure of business by Kinoy Phanthourath d/b/a Thai Kitchen, 620 North 9<sup>th</sup> Street. A Class “E” license entitles the licensee to sell beer and wine only, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only. This is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-111** An Ordinance To Increase The Number Of Subclass 2 Liquor Licenses By One For Jeneric217, Inc. D/B/A The Planet, 126 E. Jefferson Street **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

Jeneric217, Inc. d/b/a The Planet, has applied for a Subclass “2” liquor license for the business at 126 E. Jefferson Street. A Subclass “2” liquor license entitles the licensee to stay open till 3 a.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings. This would increase the number of Subclass “2” licenses from six to seven. This is an additional license to what the licensee already has which is a Class “A” (tavern license) that allows the licensee to sell onsite for consumption from glass or pitcher only and is a 1 a.m. license.

**2009-112** An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of An Agreement With Paul O’Shea For Planning And Design Services In An Amount Not To Exceed \$65,000.00 From March 27, 2009, Through March 26, 2010, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

An ordinance authorizing the execution of a one-year agreement between the City of Springfield and Paul W. O’Shea to provide planning and design services to the Office of Planning & Economic Development for the time period covering March 27, 2009 through March 26, 2010, in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00.

**2009-113** An Ordinance Authorizing Additional Payment Of \$14,578.02 For A Total Amount Not To Exceed \$85,669.02 To Ferry & Associates Architects, LLC, For Required Additional Tests And Modifications To The Architectural Plans For Properties Located In The South Town Redevelopment Area At 1100 South Grand Avenue East (Ordinance Number 793-11-07), 1322 S. 11<sup>th</sup> Street, 1031 South Grand Avenue East (Ordinance Number 794-11-07), 1104 South Grand Avenue East (Ordinance Number 81-02-08) And 1121 South Grand Avenue East (Ordinance Number 82-02-08), Utilizing Community Development Block Grant Funds For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

An ordinance amending ordinance no. 81.02.08 (an ordinance authorizing execution of an architectural service agreement with Ferry & Associates Architects, LLC, for the property

located in the South Town Redevelopment area at 1104 South Grand Avenue East and approving payment in the amount of \$15,200.00 for these services utilizing Community Development Block Grant funds for the Office of Planning and Economic Development), by authorizing an additional \$2,667.50 for total amount not to exceed \$17,867.50. The project required additional tests and modifications to the architectural plans requested by Building and Zoning that Ferry & Associates performed or contracted with others to perform.

**2009-114** An Ordinance Authorizing The Execution Of A Redevelopment Agreement With The Springfield Office Of Public Works For Demolition Of Unsafe And Dangerous Vacant Residential Structures Utilizing Enos Park Tax Increment Finance Funds In An Amount Not To Exceed \$150,000.00, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

Authorizes OPED to enter into a Redevelopment Agreement with the Office of Public Works – Division of Unsafe Structures for the demolition of 30 unoccupied, unsafe and dangerous vacant residential structures with the Enos Park TIF district.

**2009-115** An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of Subrecipient Agreement No. 08-Sr-0005 With The City Of Springfield Office Of Public Works-Division Of Unsafe Structures, For Demolition Of Unsafe And Dangerous Vacant Residential Structures Utilizing The City's Community Development Block Grant Funds In An Amount Not To Exceed \$150,000.00, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

Authorizes OPED to enter into a Subrecipient Agreement 08-SR-0005 with the Office of Public Works – Division of Unsafe Structures for the demolition of 30 unoccupied, unsafe and dangerous vacant residential structures. The activity is CDBG eligible under 24 CFR 570.201(d), Clearance. The activity meets HUD's broad national objective of addressing slum and blight on a spot basis under 24 CFR 570.208(b)(2)

**2009-116** An Ordinance Declaring 12 Unclaimed Bicycles Being Held In The Springfield Police Department's Evidence Room To Be Surplus Property And Authorizing The Springfield Police Department To Donate Said Bicycles To The Capital Area Career Center **(Requested By Ald. Dove) (Public Affairs And Safety)**

An ordinance declaring 12 unclaimed bicycles being held in the Springfield Police Department's Evidence room to be surplus property and authorizing the Springfield Police Department to donate said bicycles to The Capital Area Career Center, not-for-profit organization.

**2009-117** An Ordinance Authorizing Payment To Motorola Sales And Services, Inc. FKA Motorola Communications And Electronics, Inc., To Furnish Maintenance On Communications Equipment Used By Various Offices And Departments Of The City From March 1, 2009, Through February 28, 2010, In An Amount Not To Exceed \$29,989.00 For

The Office Of Homeland Security Bureau Of Emergency Communications (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Maintenance on communications infrastructure maintained by the Bureau of Emergency Communications and used by several City Departments. The contract is with the manufacturer of the equipment.

**2009-118** An Ordinance Authorizing Execution Of A Redevelopment Agreement With The City Of Springfield Office Of Public Works And Authorizing Purchase Of New Park Benches From Howard L. White & Associates, Inc. Utilizing Central Area Tax Increment Finance Funds In An Amount Not To Exceed \$177,121.00, For The Office Of Planning And Economic Development (**Requested By Ald. Dove**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

TIF funding for the purchase of 172 new park benches to be located within the boundaries of the Central Area TIF District.

**2009-119** An Ordinance Authorizing The Execution Of A Collective Bargaining Agreement With The International Association Of Firefighters, Local #37, On Behalf Of The Springfield Firefighters For The Time Period Covering March 1, 2008, Through February 28, 2013 (**Requested By Ald. Cimarossa**) (**Public Affairs And Safety**)

Across-the-Board increases; March 1, 2008 – 3%, September 1, 2008 – 1%, March 1, 2009 – 3%, September 1, 2009 – 1%, March 1, 2010 – 3%, September 1, 2010 – 1%, March 1, 2011 – 3%, September 1, 2011 – 1%, March 1, 2012 – 3%, September 1, 2012 – 1%. Effective September 1, 2009, employees in the bargaining unit will be subject to random drug and/or alcohol testing. Establish the position of Relief Captain. Staff members of the Department will no longer be counted in the minimum manning for purposes of layoff. Employees who are laid off will be subject to recall for a period of three years. Currently it is only one year.
