**2009-183** An Ordinance Authorizing Additional Payment Of \$175,284.00 To Kinney Contractors, Inc. For A Total Amount Not To Exceed \$571,794.00 Under Contract PW09-07-58 For The 2008 Concrete Patching Program For The Office Of Public Works (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Works**)

This ordinance is for additional payment for the 2008 concrete patching program. This increase is due to additional quantities at the same unit price.

**2009-184** An Ordinance Authorizing The Purchase Of Reflective Sign Material From 3m Traffic Safety Systems Division In An Amount Not To Exceed \$16,977.00 Under State Contract PSD 4104267 For The Office Of Public Works (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Works**)

This ordinance will authorize the annual purchase of reflective film for the 2009 re-stocking of sign materials under State Contract pricing.

**2009-185** An Ordinance Authorizing The Execution Of An Agreement With Capitol Landscape Recycling, LLC To Lease Land At 2100 E. Moffat Avenue To Be Used As A Branch Storage Facility For An Amount Not To Exceed \$24,000.00 From May 7, 2009, Through May 6, 2010, For The Office Of Public Works (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Works**)

This ordinance will authorize the execution of an agreement with Capitol Landscape Recycling, LLC for the lease of land at 2100 Moffat Street to serve as our temporary branch storage facility. This twelve month lease shall begin May 7, 2009 and continue until May 6, 2010 at a cost of \$2,000.00 per month.

**2009-186** An Ordinance Approving The Final Plat Of Manchester Woods, Second Addition, For The Office Of Public Works (**Requested By Ald. Lesko**) (**Public Works**)

An ordinance approving the final plat of Manchester Woods, Second Addition for the Office of Public Works. The subdivision is located east of Peoria Road and south of Veteran's Parkway.

**2009-192** An Ordinance Amending Chapter 170, Section 170.10.25(B)(2) Of The 1988 City Of Springfield Code Of Ordinances, As Amended, To Revise The Residential Fee Schedule For Building Permits (**Requested By Ald. Griffin**) (**Public Works**)

The Springfield Area Home Builders Association has requested a revision to the Residential Building Permit fee schedule. Currently, the building permit fee for a new residence is based solely upon the declared value of the new building. This ordinance would revise the building permit fee to be based upon the actual square footage of the residence, which would be verified during the Plan Review stage. The revised fee would be calculated at \$.20 per square foot of living space. The current fee for a new 1, 200 sq ft house with a declared value of \$100,000 would be \$224.50, and the revised fee would be \$240.00. The current fee for a new 1,800 sq ft house with a declared value of \$200,000 would be \$399.50, and the revised fee would be \$360.00.
