AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$44,212.19 FOR REPAIR OF THE DALLMAN POWER PLANT UNIT 33 SOUTH BOILER FEED PUMP WITH FLOWSERVE US INC. FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT PAYABLE OF \$164,212.19 TO SAID VENDOR FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes an additional expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$44,212.19 for repair of the Dallman Power Plant Unit 33 South Boiler Feed Pump for the City of Springfield Office of Public Utilities' Electric Division Generation Department, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 269-07-10 approved payment in an amount not to exceed \$120,000.00 to Flowserve US Inc. for the repair of the Dallman Power Plant Unit 33 South Boiler Feed Pump, \$104,986.00 of which was for equipment with the remaining \$14,298.00 allocated for anticipated labor charges, and

WHEREAS, the original expenditure authorization was based upon the estimated repair of the equipment, and

WHEREAS, the inspections and repairs are now complete, resulting in the above referenced additional labor expenses, and additional funding is now necessary because existing funds are insufficient to cover this equipment repair, and

WHEREAS, the original ordinance and this funding increase authorize the expenditure of \$164,212.19 in total for these repairs.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A PROPOSAL WITH JORDAN TRANSFORMER, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$135,986.00 FOR REPAIR OF THE LAKE PARK TRANSFORMER NO. 1 FOR THE ELECTRIC DIVISION FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts a Proposal in the amount of \$135,986.00 from Jordan Transformer, LLC for repair of the Lake Park Transformer No. 1 due to damages resulting from a vehicle accident in which a motorist collided with the transformer, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to this incident, the transformer was shipped to Jordan Transformer, LLC for inspection and testing, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the vendor's inspection report, the Lake Park Transformer No. 1 will require a complete redesign and repair to like-new condition for an estimated price of \$119,021.00, and

WHEREAS, these repairs will include: new high voltage and low voltage disc windings with copper conductor, new mineral oil, new Weidmann insulation package, new leads and wooden lead structure, new control cabinet, new drain valve, and a new nameplate, and

WHEREAS, besides these repairs, the utility will spend another \$13,110.00 for general maintenance repairs to this transformer unit, and approximately \$3,855.00 to ship the unit back to Springfield upon completion of the repairs, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 38.42 of the City Code, the Purchasing Agent has determined that this contract is not subject to sealed competitive bidding.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING PAYMENT TO PROLIANCE ENERGY, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000,000.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF NATURAL GAS FOR THE INTERSTATE COMBUSTION TURBINE THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2012 UNDER AN EXISTING CONTRACT FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield Office of Public Utilities Interstate Combustion Turbine requires natural gas for commercial operation, and

WHEREAS, the Interstate unit is primarily used to meet summer peak load requirements, as well as wholesale electricity sales, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 38.42 of the City Code, the Purchasing Agent has determined that this contract is not subject to sealed competitive bidding.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT FOR UTILITY MAINTENANCE AND ENGINEERING SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD AND THE RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CO. FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

WHEREAS, any material provided by the City for services under this agreement shall be reimbursed by RECC at the rate of cost plus 20%, and

WHEREAS, this agreement is on file in Office of the City Clerk.
