2011-024 Annual Appropriation Ordinance Of The City Of Springfield, Illinois, For The Fiscal Year Beginning March 1, 2011 & Ending February 29, 2012

Amendment No. 1 was adopted. Clean up Amendment. The motion to amend passed by unanimous voice vote. (10/0)

Amendment No. 2 was adopted. Restoring salary lines in COS Budget within the Police and Fire departments. The motion to amend passed by voice vote. (6/4)

Ald. Simpson, Ald. Kunz, Ald. Lesko, Ald. Cahnman, Ald. Mahoney, and Ald. Cimarossa voted Yes. Ald. Shanahan, Ald. Theilen, Ald. Smarjesse and Ald. Griffin voted No.

Amendment No. 3 was adopted. This amendment restored the salary lines in the Convention and Visitor's Bureau. The motion to amend passed by voice vote. (6/4)

Ald. Simpson, Ald. Kunz, Ald. Lesko, Ald. Cahnman, Ald. Mahoney, Ald. Cimarossa voted Yes. Ald. Shanahan, Ald. Theilen, Ald. Smarjesse and Ald. Griffin voted No.

The official vote on Agenda No. 2011-024, as amended, was 10/0. Ald. Shanahan, Ald. Simpson, Ald. Kunz, Ald. Lesko, Ald. Cahnman, Ald. Mahoney, Ald. Cimarossa, Ald. Theilen, Ald. Smarjesse, and Ald. Griffin voted yes.

Agenda No. 2011-063 was recalled by a vote of 8/3. Ald. Shanahan, Ald. Kunz, Ald. Lesko, Ald. Cimarossa, Ald. Theilen, Ald. Smarjesse, Ald. Griffin and Mayor Edwards voted yes. Ald. Simpson, Ald. Cahnman and Ald. Mahoney voted no.

Amendment No. 1 was adopted by a vote of 6/4. Amendment No. 1 reduced the amount of repayment by the Corporate Fund (from Hotel/Motel Tax loan for FY2010) from \$1,130,000.00 to \$880,247. These monies would have gone to the Capital Improvement Fund. Ald. Shanahan, Ald. Kunz, Ald. Lesko, Ald. Cimarossa, Ald. Theilen, and Ald. Smarjesse voted yes. Ald. Simpson, Ald. Cahnman, Ald. Mahoney and Ald. Griffin voted no.
