AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 90.16, 110.307 AND 110.865 OF THE 1988 CITY OF SPRINGFIELD CODE OF ORDINANCES, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO FEES CHARGED FOR BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, section 90.16 currently sets forth a \$25 fee for background investigations of individuals, managers, new partners or new corporate officers or directors seeking a liquor license; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to increase the background investigation fee to \$39.25 in order to cover the actual cost of the background investigations; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 110 does not include a provision for the cost of a background investigation for applicants of either a taxicab driver's license or a pedicab license; and

WHEREAS, in order to cover actual costs, it is in the best interest of the City to charge a background investigation fee of \$39.25 on all applicants for a taxicab driver's license and a pedicab license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby amends Chapter 90, Section 90.16 of the 1988 Springfield City Code of Ordinances, as amended, as follows:

CHAPTER 90. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

§ 90.16. - Application and investigation fees.

The following fees will accompany applications authorized by this chapter:

Annual renewal/investigation fee for licenses and outdoor café permits and caterer retailer permits	25
Application for change of location only	40
Application for change of name of licensed premises only	15
Background investigation of an individual, a manager, new partner, or new corporate officer or director	2539.25

Application for permit for outdoor café	25
Late payment fee	50
Installment fee for annual licenses or annual permits (due with first payment)	75

Section 2: That the City Council hereby amends Chapter 110, Section 110.307 of the 1988 Springfield City Code of Ordinances, as amended, as follows:

§110.307. Taxicab driver's license.

(a) No person shall drive a taxicab unless he has been issued a taxicab driver's license and a taxicab operator's license. However, a taxicab operator's license shall not be required if the driver is employed by, contracted with, leasing a taxicab from or providing taxicab driver's services by other arrangement with a licensed taxicab operator.

(b) The taxicab driver's license fee shall be \$15 for the driver's first year, and \$10 annually thereafter for renewal. All applications for a taxicab driver's license shall also be accompanied by a background investigation fee of \$39.25.

(c) The approving authority shall be the mayor.

Section 3: That the City Council hereby amends Chapter 110, Section 110.865 of the 1988 Springfield City Code of Ordinances, as amended, as follows:

§ 110.865. - Pedicab license.

(a) No person shall drive a pedicab unless he/she has been issued a pedicab license. However, a pedicab operator's license shall not be required if the driver is employed by, contracted with, leasing a pedicab from or providing pedicab services by other arrangement with a licensed pedicab operator.

(b) The pedicab driver's license fee shall be \$15 for the driver's first year, and \$10 annually thereafter for renewal. The license shall run from July 31 to July 31 of the following year. All applications for a pedicab license shall also be accompanied by a background investigation fee of \$39.25.

(c) The approving authority shall be the mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$107,934.00 FOR THE OFFICE OF COMMUNICATIONS TO PURCHASE BROADCAST EQUIPMENT AND RELATED EXPENSES FOR THE AUDIO-VISUAL UNIT

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby authorizes a supplemental appropriation of FY11 funds in the amount of \$107,934.00 for the Office of Communications to be spent for broadcast equipment and related expenses for Public Access Channel 4 and Government Access Channel 18.

Section 2: That the Office of Budget and Management is hereby directed to effectuate the supplemental appropriation from unappropriated fund balance for the Office of Communications as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF CONTRACT #CS06-08-45 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2011, WITH, AND ADDITIONAL PAYMENT OF \$25,000.00 FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$780,000.00 TO, WATTS COPY SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE LEASE OF DIGITAL COPY MACHINES AND AUXILIARY EQUIPMENT FOR THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously passed Ord. No. 682-10-05 authorizing execution of Contract #CS06-08-45 with Watts Copy Systems, Inc. for the lease of digital copy machines and auxiliary equipment through September 30, 2008, for all City Departments in an amount not to exceed \$455,000.00; and

WHEREAS, provisions in Section 2 of the Agreement authorize extensions by mutual agreement of the parties; and

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE ORIGINAL WEBCOMPLIANCE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH OPEN ACCESS TECHNOLOGY INTERNATIONAL, INC. FOR WEBCOMPLIANCE SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF \$55,620.00 IN ADDITIONAL RECURRING FEES FOR ANOTHER 36-MONTH TERM, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT PAYABLE OF \$134,620.00 TO SAID VENDOR FOR THE ELECTRIC DIVISION FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

WHEREAS, this Ordinance approves and authorizes execution of Agreement Amendment No. 1 to the original webCompliance Service Agreement approved under Ordinance No. 105-02-08 with Open Access Technology International, Inc. for webCompliance Subscription Services for a three-year term in the total amount of \$79,000.00 for the Electric Division Transmission, Distribution and Operations Department for the Office of Public Utilities, and

WHEREAS, webCompliance is a web-based tracking service that provides the utility the ability to document its compliance with the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) and Southeastern Electric Reliability Council (SERC) standards, and

WHEREAS, the original ordinance and service agreement included setup, initiation and training at a price of \$25,000.00, plus a recurring service fee of \$1,500.00 paid monthly for the initial 36-month term, and

WHEREAS, this Agreement Amendment is necessary to authorize payment of additional recurring monthly fees for these services for another 36-month term, the cost of which shall now be \$1,545.00 per month for a total payment of \$55,620.00 to said vendor during said extended service term, and

WHEREAS, the Original Ordinance and this Agreement Amendment bring the expenditure authorization with Open Access Technology International, Inc. to \$134,620.00 for these services, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 38.40 of the City Code, the Purchasing Agent has determined that this contract is not subject to sealed competitive bidding.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A LETTER OFFER FOR EXTENSION, APPROVING A ONE-YEAR CONTRACT EXTENSION AND AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$112,545.00 UNDER CONTRACT NO. UW11-08-45 WITH MOSAIC CROP NUTRITION, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF FLUOROSILICIC ACID FOR THE WATER PURIFICATION PLANT FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT PAYABLE OF \$225,090.00 UNDER SAID CONTRACT FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

Section 1: That the attached partial plat of vacation attached hereto as Exhibit A, over the above-described real property, is approved by the City.



**AN ORDINANCE DÉCLARING REAL PROPERTY AND CONTENTS
LOCATED AT 1411 AND 1415 E. JEFFERSON STREET TO BE SURPLUS
PROPERTY, DIRECTING THE SALE OF SAID REAL PROPERTY AND
AUTHORIZING THE PUBLICATION OF A NOTICE OF SAID SALE AND
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City owns certain real property located at 1411 and 1415 E. Jefferson Street, legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein, including the improvements located thereon (the "Real Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Real Property was formerly used by the Sangamon County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Real Property contains buildings, contents therein, parking lots and adjoining vacant property (collectively "Surplus Property"), is no longer necessary, appropriate, required for the use of, profitable to, or for the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to dispose of the Real Property and Surplus Property by sale for cash; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to the public interest that any purchase shall be subject to certain specifications established by the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-2, the City may sell the Real Property by inviting proposals for the purchase of the Real Property by publishing notice for three successive weeks in a newspaper published in the City, and the City Council desires that such notice of sale and request for proposals provide for the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto and any other terms and conditions deemed necessary by the City's Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, an ordinance authorizing the execution of an agreement for the sale of the Real Property shall be submitted to the City Council for approval prior to the sale of the Real Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby directs a sale of the Real Property located at 1411 and 1415 E. Jefferson Street, legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto, and authorizes the City's Purchasing Agent to publish a notice of sale and request for proposals in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit B including the terms and conditions contained therein and any other terms and conditions deemed necessary by the City's Purchasing Agent.

Section 2: The City's Purchasing Agent shall publish said notice of sale and request for proposals at the first opportunity for three successive weeks in a newspaper published in the City.

Section 3: That the City Council hereby declares 1411 and 1415 E. Jefferson Street, the buildings and contents therein as well as the parking lots and adjoining vacant property as "Surplus Property" and authorizes the sale of said Surplus Property.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$6,000.00 FROM ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO COVER ELIGIBLE GRANT EXPENDITURES FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES
FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs, and

WHEREAS, this City has received a \$6,000.00 Grant from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR), and

WHEREAS, due to the urgent nature of this grant, Emergency passage of this ordinance is necessary so that participants can start work as soon as possible, as the program was just announced by the State on July 5, 2011, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Springfield Office of Public Utilities to accept said grant funds from the IDNR, and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield Office of Public Utilities is requesting a supplemental appropriation from these funds in the total amount of \$6,000.00 into Lake Services Maintenance Account No. 101-200-JAAD-6318-1103.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1.
