

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE SOLE SOURCE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF CONTRACT NB16-107C WITH SANGAMON VALLEY LANDFILL AND WASTE MANAGEMENT OF ILLINOIS, INC. FOR THE DISPOSAL OF DEMOLITION DEBRIS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$185,000.00 FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC WORKS**

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article 38.40 of the City Purchasing Code, this purchase is except from the City's requirements for Sealed Competitive Bids; and

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH  
MEMORIAL HEALTH SYSTEM IN REGARDS TO THE LEASE OF AIR SPACE  
OVER CARPENTER STREET, FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC WORKS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, Memorial Health System ("MHS"), is a provider of medical services to the general public, including the residents of Springfield, Sangamon County, and Central Illinois, and is the parent corporation of Memorial medical Center, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, (hereinafter called "MMC"); and

**WHEREAS**, MHS is the owner of a medical building known as the Memorial Center for Learning and Innovation (the "Learning Center"). The services provided in the Learning Center benefit the general public by education and instructing physicians, medical students, other medical professionals and the public in advancements in medical care and treatment to enhance the standard of healthcare in Springfield and the Sangamon County area; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a parking garage (the "Learning Center Parking Garage") attached to said Learning Center that serves the Learning Center and the MMC Hospital campus. The Learning Center and the attached Learning Center Parking Garage are situated in the block bounded on the North by Miller Street, on the East by Klein Street, on the South by Carpenter Street and on the West by Rutledge Street;

**WHEREAS**, MHS desires to construct a pedestrian walkway over Carpenter Street from the South side of the Learning Center Parking Garage to connect to the North side of a medical office building to be sued by the SIU School of Medicine (the "SIU Medical Office Building") which MHS intends to construct on the North half of the block bounded by Rutledge Street on the West, Carpenter Street on the North, Klein Street on the East and Reynolds Street on the South; and

**WHEREAS**, said pedestrian walkway will benefit the general public, physicians, medical personnel and patients using the new SIU Medical Office Building, the parking garage, the Learning Center and Memorial Hospital; and

**WHEREAS**, the connecting pedestrian walkway over Carpenter Street will provide a safer means of access to and from the new Learning Center Building, the Learning Center Parking Garage and the new SIU Medical Office Building, for physicians, medical personnel, visitors, patients, and employees, and will relieve traffic congestion by enabling people to park at one site and to then use the new SIU Medical Office Building, the Learning Center and the parking garages without moving their vehicles; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:**

**Section 1:** That the City Council hereby approves and authorizes the execution of an agreement between the City of Springfield and Memorial Health System in regard to the lease of air space over Carpenter Street. This is to allow Memorial Health System to construct and maintain a skywalk over Carpenter Street between Rutledge Street and Klein Street. This connection will link a proposed SIU School of Medicine medical building and the Memorial Center for Learning and Innovation.

**Section 2:** That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and recording by the City Clerk.



AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH MEMORIAL HEALTH SYSTEM AND AMEREN ILLINOIS COMPANY FOR RELOCATION OF A 69KV TRANSMISSION LINE ON CARPENTER AND FIRST STREETS FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC UTILITIES

WHEREAS, Memorial Health System ("Memorial") wishes to construct a pedestrian bridge over and across Carpenter Street between Rutledge Street on the West and Klein Street on the East, and

WHEREAS, in order to construct the bridge, it is necessary to relocate certain electric distribution lines and to remove a transmission line along with associated equipment, and

WHEREAS, Memorial will pay the cost for all of the relocation and no work will be paid for with public funds, and

WHEREAS, a copy of the agreement shall be on file with the Office of the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AND BRIGHT NEW DAY INVESTMENTS, LLC, AN ILLINOIS LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY IN REGARD TO LEASE OF AIR SPACE OVER A PORTION OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN 520 E. MONROE STREET AND 524 E. MONROE STREET**

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WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Bright New Day Investments, LLC, an Illinois Limited Liability Company is a company redeveloping blighted properties; and

WHEREAS, the Bright New Day desires to connect buildings located at the street addresses of 518, 520 and 524 E. Monroe Street, Springfield, Illinois (the "Premises"), by constructing a connecting link from the second floor elevation of 520 E. Monroe Street being approximately 14' 6" above grade up to 20' above the roof top elevation of 524 E. Monroe Street, said link will contain a stairway and walkway among the buildings as well as elevators to service them over the City's alley to link the aforementioned buildings;; and

WHEREAS, the connecting link over the alley will provide a safer means of pedestrian access to and from the Bright New Day's buildings; and

WHEREAS, the additional jobs that will be provided by such redevelopment of Bright New Day's buildings, the increased property taxes which will benefit the City of Springfield arising from the Bright New Day's buildings including the connecting stairway and walkway; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to paragraphs 11-75-1 and 11-80-8 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-75-1 and 11-80-8, the City may regulate the use of the space over streets, alleys, other municipal property and public places of the city; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to enter into an agreement with Bright New Day, to lease air space over a portion of the airspace above the alley between 520 E. Monroe Street and 524 E. Monroe Street; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Agreement shall be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:**



**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, IL AND BRIGHT NEW DAY INVESTMENTS, LLC, AN ILLINOIS LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND OPERATION OF AN UNDERGROUND TUNNEL IN THE ALLEY BETWEEN 520 E. MONROE STREET AND 524 E. MONROE STREET**

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Springfield, Illinois, to grant a license to Bright New Day Investments, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company, for the construction, maintenance, repair and operation of an underground tunnel located in the Alley between 520 E. Monroe Street and 524 E. Monroe; and

WHEREAS, the alley under which this tunnel is to be constructed is legally described on attached Exhibit "A," and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that said license be granted; and

WHEREAS, the original license shall be recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds and returned to the Office of Public Works for filing with the Office of the City Clerk.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:**

**Section 1:** That the City Council of the City of Springfield, Illinois, hereby authorizes the granting of a license to Bright New Day Investments, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company, for the construction, maintenance, repair and operation of an underground tunnel located in the alley between 520 E. Monroe Street and 524 E. Monroe Street. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute said license on behalf of the City of Springfield.

**Section 2:** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to have this license recorded with the Sangamon County Office of the Recorder of Deeds upon passage of this ordinance.




