

**A RESOLUTION NOTIFYING THE STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION THAT MOTOR FUEL TAX FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$698,802.00, MAY BE USED FOR THE COCKRELL LANE PHASE II, MFT
SECTION NO. 20-00399-02-BR, FOR THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC WORKS**

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates using Motor Fuel Tax funds in the amount of \$698, 802.00 for preliminary engineering services for the Cockrell Lane Phase II improvements from I-72 to approximately 500' south of the UP railroad bridge, which also includes approximately 500' of improvements to Mathers Road; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to notify the State regarding the expenditure of Motor Fuel Tax funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the funds will be used for preliminary engineering services under the Illinois Highway Code.

Section 2: That the City anticipates using \$698,802.00 for the Cockrell Lane Phase II, MFT Section No. 20-00399-02-BR from its allotment of Motor Fuel Tax Funds.

Section 3: That said work shall be done by contract.

Section 4: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit two (2) certified copies of this resolution to the Illinois Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, through its District Engineer.

Section 5: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and recording by the City Clerk.
