WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a home rule unit as defined in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates using Motor Fuel Tax funds in the amount of \$698, 802.00 for preliminary engineering services for the Cockrell Lane Phase II improvements from I-72 to approximately 500' south of the UP railroad bridge, which also includes approximately 500' of improvements to Mathers Road; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to notify the State regarding the expenditure of Motor Fuel Tax funds.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the funds will be used for preliminary engineering services under the Illinois Highway Code.

Section 2: That the City anticipates using \$698,802.00 for the Cockrell Lane Phase II, MFT Section No. 20-00399-02-BR from its allotment of Motor Fuel Tax Funds.

**Section 3:** That said work shall be done by contract.

<u>Section 4</u>: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit two (2) certified copies of this resolution to the Illinois Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, through its District Engineer.
